- First name and last name
- Date of birth
- Your Account number
- Address & postcode
- Contact phone number
- Contact email address

Then, we'll send you a one-time code to the mobile number or email address we have saved on your account. Once you've confirmed the code, we'll be ready to make the changes for you as required.
